## 1 **START + END HERE**

### PRAY FOR CHRIST FOLLOWERS

**THANK** God for salvation.

**LISTEN** to the Word of God. Read John 17:20-21.

**AS WE WALK...**

focus on breathing deep, steady and slowing your pace while you reflect on this question:

### PRAY FOR THE ENVIRONMENT AND CULTURE

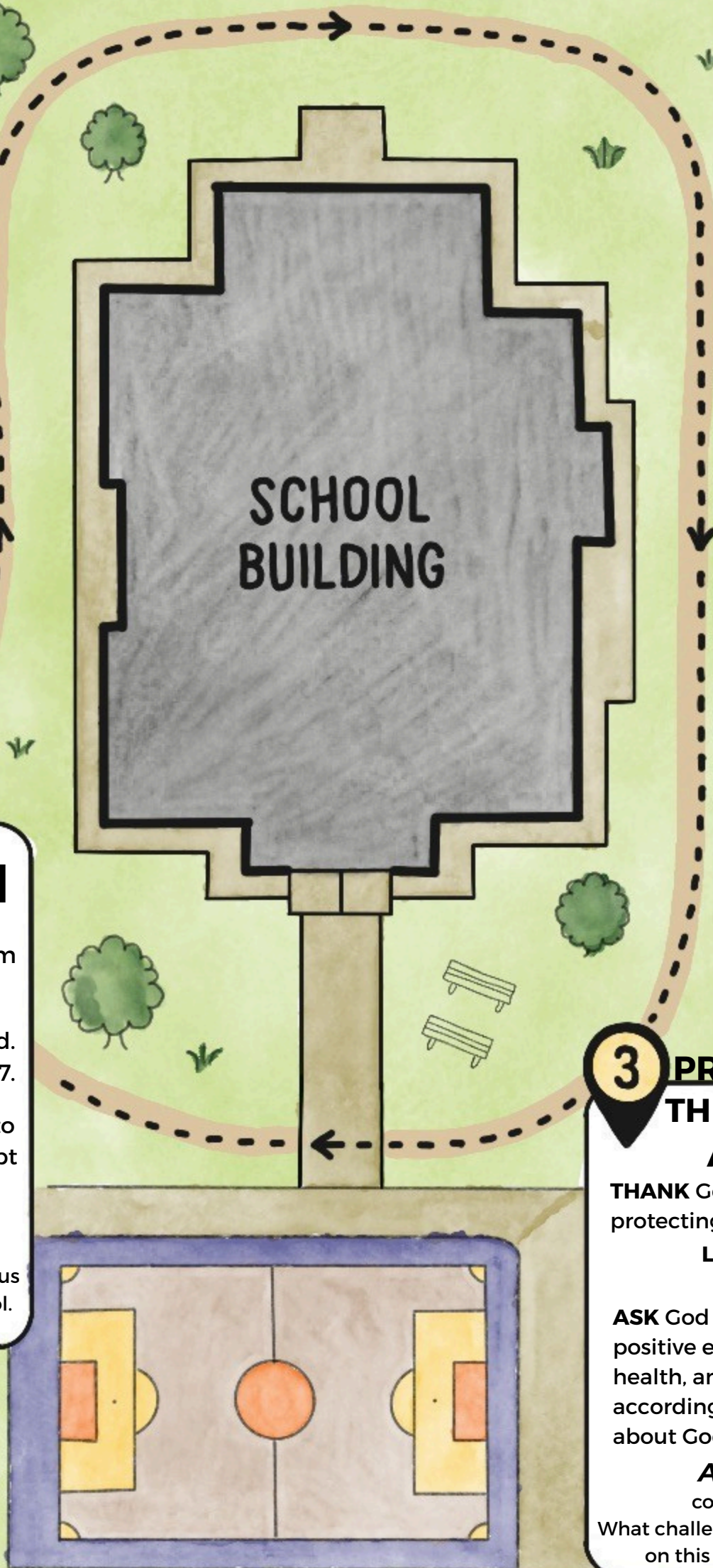
**THANK** God for watching over and protecting this school.

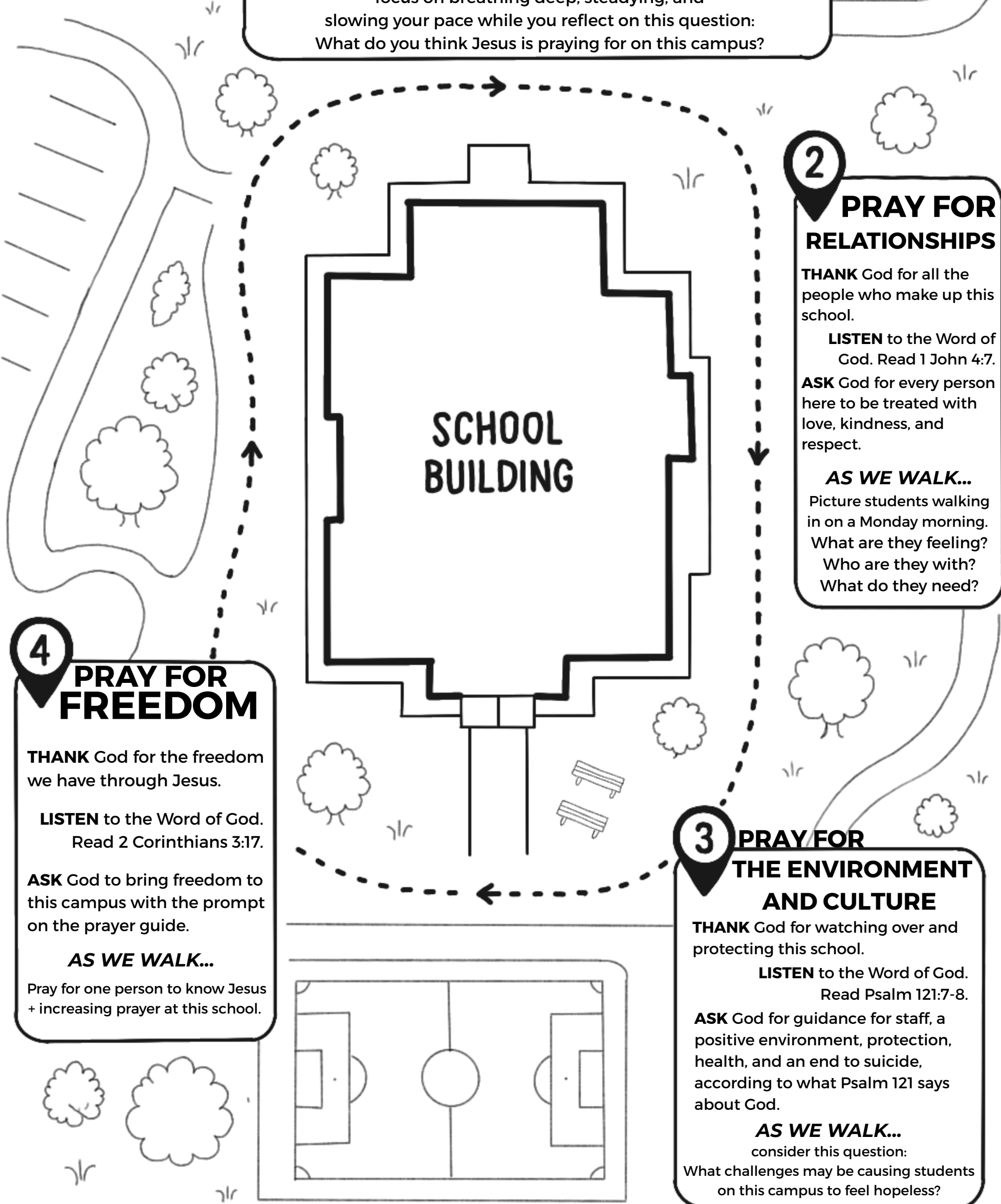
## 3 PRAY FOR THE ENVIRONMENT AND CULTURE

**AS WE WALK...**  
consider this question:  
What challenges may be causing students on this campus to feel hopeless?



# PRAYER WALK GUIDE

Meet at the front of the school for your first prayer topic. You will stop three more times at each side of the school. At each stop, follow the prayer prompt listed next to 'THANK', 'LISTEN', and 'ASK.' After you close the 'ASK' portion of each topic, read the 'As we walk...' prompt aloud to the group to reflect on as you walk to the next side of the school and prepare to pray for the next topic. Follow the school diagram for a visual of your path.

## 1. Pray for Christ Followers (pray together aloud all at once)

**THANK** God for salvation out loud in your group.

**LISTEN** to and silently reflect on this verse:

John 17:20-21 says, *"My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me."*

**ASK** God to raise up bold, authentic, compassionate, and unified Christ followers on this campus. Pray out loud at the same time.

**As we walk...**

focus on breathing deep, steady and slowing your pace while you reflect on this question: What do you think Jesus is praying for on this campus?

## 2. Pray for Relationships (take turns praying aloud one at a time)

**THANK** God for every person in this school—students, staff, volunteers, etc., out loud in your group.

**LISTEN** to and reflect on this verse:

1 John 4:7 says, *"Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God."*

**ASK** God for every person here to be treated with love, kindness, and respect.

**As we walk...**

Picture students walking in on a Monday morning. What are they feeling? Who are they with? What do they need?

## 3. Pray for the Environment/Culture (pray silently and individually)

**THANK** God for watching over and protecting this school silently in your group.

**LISTEN** to this verse and ask God to show you how to pray.

Psalms 121:7-8 says, *"The LORD will keep you from all harm—he will watch over your life; the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore."*

**ASK** God for guidance for school staff, a positive environment, protection, physical health, and an end to suicide, according to what Psalm 121 says about God.

**As we walk...**

Consider this question: What challenges may be causing students on this campus to feel hopeless?

## 4. Pray for Freedom (declare prayer topics out loud)

**THANK** God for the freedom we have through Jesus out loud in your group.

**LISTEN** and reflect on this Scripture:

2 Corinthians 3:17 says, *"Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom."*

**ASK** God to bring freedom to this campus.

One person starts by praying, **"We invite Your Spirit to come to this campus & bring freedom from \_\_\_\_\_."** Then, have the group fill in the blank by **naming specific challenges this campus may need freedom from** (fear, anxiety, comparison, bullying, etc.).

**One person says a prayer for the things mentioned out loud in closing.**

**As we walk...** Pray for one person to know Jesus, as well as increasing prayer at this school.
